	ICLSs will be employed as Temporary Part-time Staff as per Article 2 of the National University Corporation Tohoku University Temporary Part-time Staff Regulations (2004, Reg. No. 49).
	The duration of employment is as follows (however, hiring procedures are conducted each academic year): February 16, 2024 to March 31, 2025
	ICLSs will be paid in accordance with Tohoku University's regulations on compensation. (JPY 940-1,100/hour, depending on enrollment classification) (Rate of pay as of AY 2023)
Schedule	Between 1.5 and 3 hours per week during the course period for each subject you are responsible for, about 1 or 2 hours each time of regular meetings and irregular activities such as writing articles, etc., about 2 or 3 times a half year. However, depending on the activity, there may be months in which more time is needed. Note: ICLSs who also work for other Tohoku University programs (as TAs, RAs, etc.) must ensure that they do not exceed 30 hours of work total, including ICLS duties, per week.
