④ 授業題目	Seminar on development assistance to developing countries (Japan's Official Development Assistance)
④ 授業の 目的と 概要	How should we eradicate poverty and inequality in developing countries? How should we achieve peace and justice? How should we guarantee prosperity, health, education, sustainable development, and decent work for all? Japan has been tackling these challenges for over sixty years, by providing Official Development Assistance (ODA) to developing countries with distinctive aid philosophy and unique instruments. This course introduces a basic knowledge about development issues and Japan's ODA policy and experience. Students are encouraged to think critically discuss actively about the conventional wisdom on global agendas.
④ 学修の 到達目標	The issue of development and ODA is an area where interdisciplinary approach is required. Also, it is the intersection of lofty ideals and the realities of international politics and economy. In this course, by using this challenging and interesting issue, basic literacy which is indispensable for you to live in the modern international society is actually exercised: that is, to grasp astutely the essence of the complex issue, to doubt and criticize constructively the "conventional wisdom", and to have your own unique idea about the issue. In order to achieve this goal, students are first requested to acquire basic knowledge about the issue of development and international aid, and some relevant sector knowledge such as health, peacebuilding, and environment.
④ 授業内容・ 方法と 進度予定	Classes are conducted online (real-time) via Microsoft Teams (classes on July 8, 15, and 22 may be conducted in hybrid (face-to-face and online), depending on the situation of COVID-19 infection).
