◎ 授業題目	Contemporary Issues in the International Law of the Sea (Google classroom: efq7dtl)
授業の 回目的と 概要	This course will focus on the current legal regime of the international law of the sea, through discussions on various contemporary issues in this field. It will be cover issues such as validity of baselines, navigational rights, exploration and exploitation of natural resources, maritime delimitation, measures against piracy, regulation of international fisheries, protection of the maritime environment and dispute settlement. Special attention will be given to ongoing maritime disputes in Asia.
学修の 到達目標	The goal of the course is for students to acquire an understanding of the legal regime of the international law of the sea, and to improve their ability to make presentations and engage in discussions in English.
授業内容・ 参 方法と 進度予定	The course will be conducted in person, provided that it is permissible under the faculty's guidelines and that all participants are able to attend. Otherwise, the course will be conducted online in real-time.  This course will start with a short lecture-style introduction. This introductory part will be followed by sessions which will each focus on a specific issue. In this part, each participant (or a group of participants, depending on the size of the class) will be asked to prepare answers and explanations to questions related to a particular issue. Participants will give a 20-minute presentation based on their preparations, which will be followed by a general discussion on the topic. Although some basic material will be provided, participants are expected to do additional research on their own in preparing for the presentations.
○ 成績評価 方法	Grading will be based on the quality of the presentations (60%) and participation in the discussions (40%).
