In addition, she has been appointed as an IBM Distinguished Engineer (Technical Director) and has held leadership positions such as CTO of IBM Services for Middleware and Database, and Vice President of IBM Academy of Technology Asia Pacific. She also launched IBM Japan COSMOS, a community of female engineers, and is actively involved in diversity and inclusion in the engineering community.
