授業の 9 目的と 概要	This course will consider current issues in international law, through discussions on specific issues in various areas. It will cover topics such as the sources of international law, the relationship between international and national law, the law of treaties, jurisdiction and immunities, state responsibility, the law of international organizations, the use of force and international dispute settlement.
学修の     到達目標	The goal of this course is for students to acquire a deeper understanding of some of the most important issues in international law. A further goal is for students to improve their ability to search for international law materials and analyze them and to make presentations and engage in discussions in English.
授業内容・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ 注と ・ ・ 進度予定	The course will be conducted in a hybrid format (in-person class with the option of attending online). There is a possibility of a transition to a fully online format if required by the faculty's guidelines concerning COVID-19. Please refer to the instructions from the student office about course registration for seminars. The maximum number of students for this seminar is nine (including graduate students but excluding students participating fully online).  This course will start with a short lecture-style introduction on the basics of conducting research in international law. This introductory part will be followed by sessions, which will each focus on a specific issue. In this part, each participant (or a group of participants, depending on the size of the class) will be asked to prepare answers and explanations to a set of questions related to a particular issue. Participants will give a 20-minute presentation based on their preparations, which will be followed by a general discussion on the topic. Although some basic material will be provided, participants are expected to do additional research on their own in preparing for the presentations.
