授業の ● 目的と 概要	This class will start online and switch to in-person if the situation allows. This class aims to provide an overview of the major issues and main dynamics shaping the international politics of East Asia in the early 21st century. It will cover the historical changes in the region's international order, its main actors and the key relationships between them, as well as important themes in regional politics such as institutions and norms, economic integration and regionalism, security hot-spots, and transnational forces. The class will consist of weekly readings, presentations by students, lecture and comments by the professor, and class discussion and debate. Students will be expected to follow international news, to participate actively in discussions, and to give a presentation summarising and commenting on the weekly readings at least once. They will also write a short paper relating to their presentation as well as a longer final paper.
学修の 到達目標	By the end of the class, students will be expected to have acquired a basic knowledge of the main actors and trends shaping the international politics of East Asia and to have developed the necessary tools to analyse and understand future developments. They will also have trained how to actively engage in a debate, how to summarise and present information clearly, and how to write academic papers.
