Mini Quizzes: 20% Mini quizzes will be conducted several times to ensure students' comprehension. These mainly consist of short answer questions based on the assigned readings. Final Project: 70% As the final product of the course, all the participants are required to write a short essay on one of the topics given by the instructor. The final project consists of the following three components: - Two Presentations (15% each) In the first presentation, students will share their research question of the project and its social background that shows why the question is worth exploring. The second presentation will be about the outline of the essay with its main arguments. Presenters will prepare handouts and post them on Google Classroom two days prior to the meeting so that all the course participants can read them beforehand. - Discussant Roles (10%) For each presentation, the instructor will designate one student as a discussant. The role of a discussant is to read the posted handout in advance and provide constructive comments on in-class presentations. - Final Essay (30%) Students are required to submit the complete paper at the end of the semester.
