These basic knowledge, skills and attitudes are necessary not only for students considering employment after undergraduate study, but also for students who wish to study at graduate school or pursue a research career. The course will promote students to: (1) learn from guest speakers with a variety of cultural, educational and professional backgrounds in order to gain knowledge and information that will be useful in shaping their own career perspectives; (2) engage in collaborative learning with other students in order to understand the significance of working together; and (3) review the results of their learning by providing presentations and writing reports in order to reflect the results of their studies, set career goals, and take concrete action.
