
Education at Tohoku University

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



"dc mail account"



- So, please use a new dc mail account activated on October 1 (Sun) for classes in the 2023 fall semester.



Minimum GPA (Grade Point Average) for MEXT Scholarship recipients is 2.3 in 3 full-scale.

(total credits of ① x 3) + (total credits of ② x 2) + (total credits of ③ x1) total credits for registered classes (1+2+3+4) for a year ① AA, A and 80 or more; ② B and 70-79; ③ C and 60-69; ④ D and 59 or less *Credits with E, F, G, N, and / are not included in the formula above.

➤ The status as a President Fellowship recipient is not guaranteed for four years and would be evaluated based on their performance at the end of every semester.
