

Moving into University House Sanjo II

1. Residence Registration

(1) Residence registration Date and Time

On and after March 25 (Mon.)

Monday to Friday (excluding holidays and weekends)

9:00~ 17:00

* 1 There will be registration meetings at the times stated above.

Please note that the registration must be made by the prospective resident himself/herself.

* 2 Each registration meeting takes about 30 minutes.

(2) Please be sure to bring your **residence permit** and **your ID** with you when you move in. If you cannot bring an original residence permit, please show its copy or its PDF version to the dorm staff.

(3) After attending the registration meeting, you can receive your room key.

2. Facilities in your Residence

Furnishings: wardrobe, bookshelf, study desk, chair, bed, air conditioner

Shared facilities: IH stove, dishwashing machine, refrigerator, microwave, rice cooker, dining table, chairs, washing machine, vacuum cleaner, iron, air conditioner, TV, shower room, toilets

※ Please prepare bedclothes, tableware, cookware.

(Please use the attached application if you want to rent bedding.)

※ If you wish to apply for Internet service for your room, please make a contract individually from the attached "Internet Application URL" at least two days before the move-in date (Excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays).

(Fees: Application fee 3,300yen, 1 month 3,410yen-includes rental Wi-Fi router)

3. Payment of Fees

The initial deposit of 30,000 yen and two months' rent and maintenance fee must be paid.

Please transfer the specified amount by bank within approximately two weeks after moving in.

If there is a delay in payment, please contact the dorm office after you move in.

4. Parking

You need a parking permit if you wish to park your car in University House parking area.

Please apply to the University House Sanjo II Office.

5. Other

(1) Those who violate University House Management Regulations may lose their Residence Permit or be evicted.

* Cases of residence permit cancellation or eviction

-- If you fail move in within seven days of the start of the move-in period without providing a reason.

-- If you allow unauthorized persons to stay overnight in your room.

-- If you damage the dorm facilities badly.

- If your behavior is substantially disruptive to other residents.
- If you fail to pay housing, maintenance, or other fees for three months or longer.

(2) Smoking Rules

Smoking cigarettes and burning incense are strictly prohibited all Sanjo area including your room. If your room becomes smelly or dirty due to smoking or incense, you must pay a cleaning fee.

(3) Restriction of baggage

Bringing electric home appliances or furniture is restricted. (Except for PCs.)

You can rent appliances if you wish to use them in your room.
