⑩ 授業題目	Contemporary Issues in the International Law of the Sea
授業の 個目的と 概要	This course will focus on the current legal regime of the international law of the sea through discussions on various contemporary issues in this field. It will cover issues such as the validity of baselines, navigational rights, exploration and exploitation of natural resources, maritime delimitation, measures against piracy, regulation of international fisheries, protection of the maritime environment, and dispute settlement. Special attention will be given to ongoing maritime disputes in Asia.
学習の 到達目標	The goal of the course is for students to acquire an understanding of the legal regime of the international law of the sea and to improve their ability to make presentations and engage in discussions in English.
授業内容 優方法 進度予定	The course will be conducted in person. This course will start with a short lecture-style introduction. This introductory part will be followed by sessions that will each focus on a specific issue. In this part, each participant (or a group of participants, depending on the size of the class) will be asked to prepare answers and explanations to questions related to a particular issue. Participants will give a 20-minute presentation based on their preparations, which will be followed by a general discussion on the topic. Although some basic material will be provided, participants are expected to do additional research on their own in preparing for the presentations. The course schedule is as follows (subject to adjustments depending on the number of participants): 1. Introduction (week 1) 2. Guide to Conducting Research in International Law (week 2) 3. Recent Developments in the Law of the Sea (weeks 3 to 5) 4. Student Presentations and Discussions (weeks 6 to 14) 5. Concluding Discussions (week 15)
