授業題目/Class subject	Education and Social Changes in East Asia: Understanding educational development in Taiwan
授業の目的と概要/Objct and Summary of Class	<p>With a rapid economic development in the 1980s and 1990s, Taiwan has become one of the leading economies in the world. However, in the recent years, there is an emerging concern on well-being, quality of life, and resilience of the Taiwan's society. The primary objective of this course is to deepen students' understanding of Taiwan and the role of education in Taiwan's development through fieldwork in Taiwan.</p> <p>The course includes four parts. It starts with the introduction of education and social changes in East Asia. Also, it gives specific focus on education and social changes in Taiwan. In the 2nd part, it provides knowledge and skills of fieldwork, such as research proposal writing, interview methods, and research ethics. Group fieldwork will be conducted in Taiwan. In the last part, participants are required to submit a short group report of the fieldwork.</p> <p>The fieldwork will include visits to schools, universities, communities, and intercultural activities.</p> <p>Japanese students taking this course will have opportunity to apply JASSO Short-term Overseas Study Scholarship. More details will be explained in the course orientation.</p>
学習の到達目標/Goal of study	Goals of study are to enable students to: (1) have a more comprehensive and more in-depth understanding of education and social changes in the context of East Asia and beyond, (2) obtain knowledge and skills of critically analyzing educational issues, (3) acquire fieldwork skills through group work in a foreign context, and (4) improve their communication skills through group work and foreign languages.
