授業題目	CLASS SUBJECT: Law, Diversity and Globalization
授業の 回目的と 概要	COURSE OBJECTIVES AND OUTLINE: In this seminar we will be discussing the role, challenges and limitations of the law in a diverse and increasingly globalizing world by looking at 1) sexual minorities and the law, 2) gender and the law, 3) transnational businesses and the law, 4) religion and the law, and 5) the international movement of people and the legal challenges that this brings about.
学習の ● 到達目標	GOAL OF STUDY: Students will acquire a deeper understanding of how the law functions (or does not function) in the diverse and globalizing world of today. Students will learn about and analyze the various legal and non-legal challenges that minorities and other disadvantaged groups in society face, especially (where appropriate) in cross-border disputes or disputes that have a cross-national element.
授業内容・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ ・ 方法と 進度予定	CONTENTS, METHOD AND PROGRESS SCHEDULE: Various reading and audio-visual materials will be used to introduce topics. Students will be expected to complete homework reading and writing assignments, engage in class discussion, and make an individual presentation. Be warned that this course entails a fair amount of reading to be done outside of class! The tentative schedule for this course is as follows: 1. Orientation 23. Sexual minorities and the law 45. Religion and the Law 67. International Movement of People and the Law 810. Transnational Businesses and the Law 1112. Gender and the law 1315.
