

TOHOKU-DAIID (Guidebook p. 16-18)

Accessing the portal site, "Single Sign-On" is a starting point to further access to all online systems (e.g., "Student Affairs Information Service"), receive various services (e.g., downloading Microsoft 365, MATLAB), and obtain information at this university.

Temporary TOHOKU-DAI ID and PW have already been distributed when you move into the dormitory. Then please find your official TOHOKU-DAI ID and PW by yourself.





- Student ID" (e.g., C4 S/T/A B####) on your student ID card identifies you as a Tohoku University student.
- It is required for receiving a variety of services, including those on campuses and at some local facilities, such as the Miyagi Art museum, etc.



"dc mail account"

- The "dc mail account" is your official university mail account, being required to access any app of Google Suites, etc. (*Gmail, Classroom, Drive, Calendar*), including "*Meet*" to attend classes online.
- Your current dc mail account was a tentative one issued just for receiving the pre-enrollment education.

Therefore, please use a new dc mail account activated on October 1 (Tue) for classes in the fall 2024.

Japanese Language Courses

(Guidebook p. 6 & 10)

In general, all FGL students admitted through the "FGL examination" are requested to get 10 credits in the Japanese Language Category for graduation.

However, this requirement is different among FGL courses. IMAC-U and AMC students with Japanese nationality may have some flexibility in language categories if their Japanese proficiency is high enough, but AMB course students are required to get all 10 credits from the Japanese Language Category, regardless of their Japanese proficiency.

This year, all students, except for Japanese students admitted through "Global Entrance Examination", must attend the first class of "Basic Japanese I" at the 5th period on October 1 for taking "SPOT", which is a unique test that enables measurement of examinees' Japanese language proficiency. Please bring a PC that can access "eduroam" and earphones or a

headset.

- Register to the course online via Student Affairs Information System


Important Dates

Examination

 No credits for a specific course or all courses of a semester may be given.

Grading

> GPA (Grade Point Average)

"4 scale", in which the highest grade is AA (4) for 90-100 points out of 100 is implemented.



Requirement to MEXT Scholarship and President Fellowship Recipients

 Minimum GPA (Grade Point Average) for MEXT Scholarship recipients is 2.3 in 3 full-scale.

(total credits of $(1) \times 3$) + (total credits of $(2) \times 2$) + (total credits of (3)	x1)
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total credits for registered classes ((1	1+2+3+4) for a year
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(1) AA, A and 80 or more; (2) B and 70-79; (3) C and 60-69; (4) D and 59 or less
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*Credits with E, F, G, N, and / are not included in the formula above.

 The status as a President Fellowship recipient is not guaranteed for four years and would be evaluated based on their performance at the end of every semester.
