### 目的と 概要 /Objectives

An exploratory culture course, Japanese Culture C is offered for foreign students to learn about and share insights into various aspects of the living culture of Japan. The course comprises three basic approaches: discussing cultural characteristics of the nation; reading some representative literature; and conducting fieldwork at places of cultural significance. Students can sign up with either Japanese Culture A or Japanese Culture C. In large part, the course contents of both classes alternate between fall and spring semesters. Those students who are here only for the fall semester are allowed to sign up with one class but may join fieldwork activities of the other class if there are openings available.
