授業題目	Global South Politics
授業の目的と概要	<p>The study of the Global South, and especially South-South Cooperation, has regained interest among states, policy-makers, academics, and other stakeholders since the beginning of the century, often due to a professed desire to identify ways to maximize the potential benefits of the policies and practices developed by states across the Global South. The interest is also given by recent economic and diplomatic achievements of several countries of the Global South, especially Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa.</p> <p>This course is designed to introduce students to the political history and current dynamics unfolding across the Global South, providing an understanding of the diverse elements that shape and influence the political systems of Southern countries and their development models. Throughout the course, students will study the different political approaches governments in the Global South implement to promote national and regional development and challenge or insert themselves into the international system.</p> <p>Special emphasis will be placed on Japan's relations with the Global South, including Latin America and the Caribbean, Africa, the Middle East, and Southeast Asia.</p>
学修の到達目標	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To study, understand, and compare the different approaches of Global South countries in relation to domestic and foreign policy. 2. To develop a critical appreciation of recent trends across the Global South, as well as their historical roots. 3. To analyze specific case studies for a significant comprehension of the object of study. 4. To strengthen academic presentation skills through the elaboration of individual and group presentations. <p>Students should come away from the course with an understanding of the diversity of political and economic systems in the Global South, an awareness of the pressing political and economic challenges of these countries to achieve sustainable development, and an appreciation of the questions and concepts that shape the work of professionals in politics and international relations.</p>
