2 Eligibility

International students enrolled at Tohoku University as of October 2025 are eligible (undergraduate students, graduate students, research students, non-degree students, special auditing students, special research students).

(1) Students planning to enter Tohoku University from this October must apply to the dorm rooms now.

- (2) Please confirm the following before applying for dormitories.
 - 1 There is no guarantee that your first choice will be approved. Please understand that due to the number of rooms available and the number of applicants, you will likely be assigned to your second choice or lower. Every year, we receive appeals for changes of accommodations after housing has been assigned. Please do not enter a preference for a dormitory where you do not wish to live.
 - ② UH Aobayama residents pay 5,700 yen for resident services such as bedding and other rental items in addition to the room fee. Please note that <u>residents cannot refuse any of the</u> services even if they do not need them.
 - 3 Residents cannot smoke in dorms or on the premises. If you wish to smoke, please find a private apartment. <u>Because University Houses are shared dormitories, smokers cannot apply.</u>
 - 4 International House Sanjo 1 is old dormitories and the condition of the rooms is not good. There may be cosmetic damage to the walls, furniture, etc. Please be aware of this when applying for them.

3 Duration of Stay

In general, one of the periods below. Please refer to "7 Move-in date " for the move-in start date.

- 1) October 1, 2025 February 28, 2026
- 2) October 1, 2025 August 31, 2026
- <u>September 30 (or March 31). I.e., you will not be able to stay in your room until the day of the graduation ceremony.</u>
- X2 Rent for final month of residenceIf students leave the dorm by the 15th day of the final month of the approved period of stay, rent and management charges for the relevant month will be half of the regular fee.

This discount applies only to the final month written on the resident's permit.

If students do not submit the application form by the deadline, the university will assign the students to a random dormitory.

7 Move-in Date

Please attend the registration meeting at your dorm on the day you arrive. After the meeting, you will receive your room key. Students can start moving into their dorms on the date below.

Wednesday, September 24, 2025

Note: Students cannot move in on Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays.

8 Residence Permit Cancellation & Eviction

Those who fail to move in within seven days of the start of the move-in period without providing a reason, allow unauthorized persons to stay overnight in their rooms, violate University House Management Regulations or International House Regulations, or disobey instructions issued by the university or the dormitory office, may lose their Residence Permit or be evicted.
