

Announcement for Level 1 JYPE/COLABS Students

The class assignments displayed on the left were decided by a random process to ensure fairness and impartiality for everyone.

Students assigned to **C140** should remain in that class. There is no problem with your placement.

Students assigned to **C110a** or **C110b** have another option. You can choose to take one of the other Level 1 comprehensive classes (starting with 'C') or a minimum class (starting with 'M') listed below instead. At present, the number of Level 1 students is much higher than expected, and the classrooms are likely to become very crowded. Therefore, if your schedule allows, we strongly recommend that you transfer to one of the following classes (in principle, **C100a**, **C100b**, and **C120** cover the same topics as **C110a**, **C110b**, and **C140**).

- **C100a (Tue/Fri)** – Online class: 16:20-17:50, 18:00-19:30
- **C100b (Wed/Fri)** – In-person class: 08:50-10:20, 10:30-12:00
Tuesday (Classroom: C401), Friday (C403)
- **C120 (Wed/Fri)** – In-person class: 08:50-10:20, 10:30-12:00
Wednesday (C402), Friday (C404)
This class has (very probably) already exceeded capacity.
- **M100 (Tue/Thu)** – In-person class: 14:40-16:10, 16:20-17:50
Tuesday (C307), Thursday (A101)
M100 begins on December 2. It is a “Minimum Japanese” class. Please note that you will need to take the placement test if you wish to advance to a Level 2 class next semester. This class is recommended for students who don't want to spend too much time on Japanese, but still wish to gain some basic knowledge.
