Eligibility

Partner universities: University of California (UCB, UCD, UCI, UCLA, UCM, UCSD, UCSB, UCSC and UCR), University of Washington, The Pennsylvania State University, Purdue University, University of York, University College London and University of East Anglia

Eligible students: 3rd-4th year undergraduate (or equivalent) students in STEM fields.

Status: Short-term Visiting Trainee at the Institute for Excellence in Higher Education, Tohoku U.

Scholarship

JASSO (Japan Student Services Organization) scholarship (160,000JPY for 6 weeks) will be provided to outstanding students who meet the JASSO requirements.

Insurance

Students must enroll in private travel insurance themselves. GAKKENSAI-personal accident insurance for students pursuing education and research- and inbound insurance are included in the program fee.

Visa
