

Application Guidelines for Admitting Students through Double Degree Programs at Tohoku University in AY2027

These guidelines are designed to admit students through the following Double Degree Programs in the 2027 academic year. The qualifications and requirements are determined by the Memorandum of Understanding and Details of Implementation for each program.

- Double Degree Program with KTH Royal Institute of Technology, Sweden
- Double Degree Program with INSA-Lyon, France
- Double Degree Program with five schools of Ecole Centrale Group, France

Before applying, you must contact your prospective academic advisor at Tohoku University and receive their consent. And please note that only faculty members who hold the position of Professor (教授) or Associate Professor (准教授) can supervise students, and “Assistant Professor” (助教), etc. cannot be your academic advisor at Tohoku University.

Applicants to the programs mentioned above must submit the following documents to the Student Exchange Division of Tohoku University via the Application form (Google form).

※All the files, except the ID photo, must be in PDF format.

1. Double Degree application form (Google form), Tohoku University
2. Statement of your reasons for the choice of the advisor (free format, single page)
3. Statement of your reasons for applying to the program (free format, single page)
4. A letter of consent from your prospective advisor at Tohoku University
(A copy of the email indicating the professor's consent is also ok.)
5. Two recommendation letters from persons who know your academic qualifications
(e.g., Your direct supervisor and an official representative of your institution)
6. Curriculum Vitae with a passport-sized photo taken within the past six months
7. Undergraduate academic transcripts. Your academic transcript should list your academic record throughout your whole study period: courses taken, grades received, any honors or degrees awarded etc.
8. English Language Certificate (If your native language is not English)
A certificate from an internationally recognized English exam is preferable. If not available, consider obtaining a recommendation letter from your English language instructor(s.)
9. A photocopy of your passport
10. Identity Photo (JPEG)
11. Certificate of bachelor's degree or equivalent document (preferably in English)
12. Pledge of Compliance (hand-signed by yourself)

Selections will be determined through a comprehensive review of the abovementioned application and documents, and an interview between you and your prospective advisor over the Internet. Finally, we will send the results to the applicants in April (France) and December (Sweden).
