Based on Korea, we are planning to branch out upon Vietnam, China, Japan and expecting to enhance understanding of youths that whole world is facing such as environment, human right and disarmament.

The first challenge towards the globe was at 2019 GLEC Vietnam, but the final round was cancelled due to the international pandemic of COVID-19. GLEC plans to expand through Vietnam, China and Japan.

## 6 GLEC VIETNAM PROCESS

### [Step 1] Sing Up ([www.gleader.vn](http://www.gleader.vn))

- Website membership is required prior to the online registration.
- All the personal information should be based on the participating student (not guardians or agents), as well as the membership details.
- Please keep yourself updated for the latest newsletters sent to your email used in this process.

### [Step 2] Registration and Payment

- After the sign-up, all participants should register for the corresponding details. Choose 1 or 2 contest sector(s) you would like to participate in. Only students with Vietnamese nationality are applied to **Domestic**.
- Your application will be confirmed only if the payment is completed within the **registration period (2021/08/16 – 2021/09/25 20:00 VST)**. Payments which are incompletely received can result in unsuccessful registration for GLEC Vietnam and those will not be able to submit their files.
- Application fee should be paid for each sector if you participate in both sectors (Speech and Essay). Once your

payment is received you will be provided with a confirmation email within 2 days.

### [Step 3] File Submission

- Applicants will be informed to submit their contest files via GLEC online platform within the given period (2021/08/16 – 2021/10/01 20:00 VST).
- You must submit:  
**Speech sector:** Script, Voice record file  
**Essay sector:** Essay

### [Step 4] Final Round

- **Result Announcement:** 2021/10/18  
(Submitted files will be examined by the UN experts and native English professors based on the GLEC SCORING CRITERIA.)
- All qualified students for the final round will be asked to make the payment for the final round. **Payments should be made no later than 2021/10/30** and you will not be able to attend the final round unless your payment is completed within the given date. Please contact us timely if you experience any problems.
- Both **Admission Letter** and **Final Round Guidelines** will be provided via email with individual contest date and time.

### [Step 5] Award Announcement

- Award announcement will be informed through official website on 2021/12/03.
- Winners are qualified to participate GGC (Global GLEC Conference).

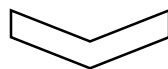

## 10 SCORING CRITERIA

### Speech

#### Preliminary Round

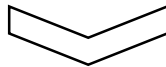
Step 1	
Component	Is there a close relationship between the presentation and the topic?
Expression	Are sentences expressed using correct grammar? Are various vocabulary and phrases used appropriately?
Forwarding Power	Did speaker deliver sentences with a smooth understandable pronunciation and intonation?



Step 2	
Component	Is logical utterance developed based on the structure of introduction-body-conclusion?
Expression	Is speaker possible to use grammar structure in a systematic way? Did speaker use many high-quality vocabulary?
Forwarding Power	Did speaker deliver sentences with a smooth understandable pronunciation and intonation?

### Final Round

Step 1	
Component	Did Speaker develop his/her own logic based on a complete understanding of the topic?
Expression	Are examples consistent with the topic properly utilized? Did speaker logically provide a rationale for the topic?
Forwarding Power	Did speaker deliver his/her opinion with a confident attitude and voice? Are nonverbal expressions actively utilized and focused?



Step 2	
Examination of native speaking professors and UN experts according to individual examination standards ※ After reviewing the on-site question-and-answer questions, the preliminary round voice file, and the final round voice file, the total score shall be determined by adding them to the results of the preliminary round score.	

### Criteria for Examination

- Fluency: Confidence & Hesitation / Flow of conversation
- Understanding of pronunciation: Pronunciation, volume & tone, rhythm

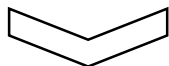
The voice file should be recorded by yourself and no grading will be done in the following cases.

- When plagiarize some or all of other people's writings
- When the writings are deviated from the topic
- When the time is exceeded
- When the submitted manuscript and the voice file do not match

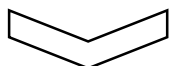

Component	Have writer selected an appropriate title for the article?
Expression	Do writer use a variety of vocabulary words correctly in context?
Forwarding Power	Is the volume properly adjusted according to the composition of the article?

Component	Are the topics and contents organically related?
Expression	Is writer possible to use grammar structure in a systematic way?
Forwarding Power	Did writer write without any spelling errors? Did writer write using the correct punctuation mark?

### Final Round

Step 1	
Component	Is the flow of writing logical?
Expression	Are various vocabulary and examples appropriately used to fit the context?
Forwarding Power	Has the thesis been developed through accurate and rich representations?



Step 2	
Examination of native speaker professors and UN experts according to individual examination standards The total score shall be determined by adding the final round essay score and the preliminary round essay score	

### Criteria for Examination

- Understanding about topic
- Example used to elaborate the topic
- Relevance of contents
- Sympathy on topic

The essay must be written in 500 to 700 words, and no grading will be done in the following cases.

- When plagiarize some or all of other people's writings
- When the writings are deviated from the topic
