<Online Application>

**What to bring:**

Student ID card, mask (you must wear a mask: non-woven masks recommended), writing implements (HB pencil and/or mechanical pencil, eraser) and a wristwatch (you cannot use a mobile phone)

Note:

- For your application, you need to complete both 1) and 2) below during the application period.
 - 1) Submit your online application (<https://www.insc.tohoku.ac.jp/japanese/registration/>). You will receive an automatic reply. Read the reply and check the bank account information for payment of the test fee.
 - 2) Transfer the test fee to the bank account provided in 1).
 - 3) Applicants who completed the application will receive a notification e-mail after the application period.
- If the number of the applicants is smaller than 10, the test will be cancelled and the test fee will be returned to the applicants.
- If the test is cancelled due to an unanticipated situation, such as a COVID-19 outbreak, the test fee will be returned to the applicants.
- You cannot take the test if you do not bring your student ID card and/or you have not arrived at the check-in desk during your assigned check-in time.
- Your score sheet will be available 14 to 16 days after you take the test.

Infection Prevention Measures:

- Upon your online application, you must input your emergency contact information, which will be provided to public institutions, such as a public health center, if necessary.
- You will not be admitted and cannot take the test if any of the following applies to you.
 - You caught an infectious disease, such as COVID-19, influenza, or measles, and have not completely recovered, unless a physician guarantees there is no danger of infection to others.
 - You entered Japan from overseas within 14 days before the test date.
 - Within 14 days before the test date, you have been in close contact with persons who traveled outside of Japan and had a fever or a cough.
 - Within 14 days before the test date, you have been in closed spaces, crowded environments, or close-contact settings (the "3Cs").
- If any of the following applies to you, check the Flow Chart of Measures to Combat the Spread of the New Coronavirus (<https://www.bureau.tohoku.ac.jp/covid19BCP/condition.html#5>) on the Tohoku University website.
 - You have been in contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
 - You feel unwell and/or have cold-like symptoms, such as a fever of 37.5 degrees Celsius or higher, altered sense of taste or smell, breathlessness, lethargy, cough, or sore throat.
 If you are not considered to be fully recovered, you will not be admitted and cannot take the test.
- At the check-in desk, your body temperature will be checked using a thermometer. If you have a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, you will not be allowed to take the test.
