Eligibility : Students enrolled at Tohoku University
(including non-degree students, excluding students on leave)

Test Fee : **3,720 yen**

Capacity : 150 (first-come-first-served basis)

Application : Online Application + Test Fee (paid via wire transfer)



<Online Application>

What to bring:

Student ID card, mask (you must wear a mask: non-woven masks recommended), writing implements (HB pencil and/or mechanical pencil, eraser) and a wristwatch (you cannot use your cell phone as a timepiece)

Note:

- For your application, you need to complete both 1) and 2) below during the application period.
 - 1) Submit your online application, and you will receive an automatic reply.
Read the reply and check the bank account information for payment of the test fee.
 - 2) Transfer the test fee to the bank account provided in 1).
 - 3) Upon completion of the application, applicants will receive a notification message via Personal Record System.
*All the messages regarding TOEFL ITP test will be announced through Personal Record System, not by Email
- If the number of the applicants is smaller than 10, the test will be cancelled and the test fee will be returned to the applicants.
- If the test is cancelled due to an unanticipated situation, such as a COVID-19 outbreak, the test fee will be refunded to the applicants.
- You cannot take the test if you do not bring your student ID card and/or you have not arrived at the check-in desk during your assigned check-in time.
- Your score sheet will be available 14 to 16 days after you take the test.

Infection Prevention Measures:

- Upon your online application, you must input your emergency contact information. This might be provided to public institutions, such as public health centers, as needed.
- You will not be admitted and cannot take the test if any of the following applies to you:
 - You caught an infectious disease, such as COVID-19, influenza, or measles, and have not completely recovered, unless a physician guarantees there is no risk of infection to others.
 - If you had a close contact with a Covid-19 positive individual.
 - If you are still in the home quarantine period, if applicable, after entry into Japan.
 - If you had close contact with individuals who are still in the home quarantine period.

- If any of the following applies to you, check the Flow Chart of Measures to Combat the New Coronavirus (<https://www.bureau.tohoku.ac.jp/covid19BCP/condition.html#5>) on the Tohoku University website.
 - You have been in contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
 - You feel unwell and/or have cold-like symptoms, such as a fever of 37.5 degrees Celsius or higher, altered sense of taste or smell, breathlessness, lethargy, cough, or sore throat.
- If you are not considered to be fully recovered, you will not be admitted and cannot take the test.
- At the check-in desk, your body temperature will be checked using a thermometer. If you have a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, you will not be allowed to take the test.
