

*** Benefits (Fee-Paying Students Only)**

Early Bird Promotion

All students who successfully register by October 12(Thu) and make a full tuition fee by October 26 (Thu) will get up to 15% off.

The Early Course registration and Dormitory reservation chance will be exclusively given to the Early Bird Promotion recipients.

2 APRU & AEARU Associate University Scholarship (100,000 KRW)

All students who are enrolled in the APRU and AEARU associate university will receive the APRU & AEARU scholarship and it will be deducted from the tuition fee.

3 Re-Enrollment Benefit (100,000 KRW)

All students who have aprticipated in the YISS or WAY program in the past are eligible to receive a fee benefit and it will be deducted from the tuition fee.

4 Yonsei Alumni Scholarship (200,000 KRW)

All students whose parents are graduate of Yonsei University are elibible to the Yonsei Alumni Scholarship.

*** Payment Method**

- **1 Domestic Wire Transfer**: Wire transfer information will be provided by email after the online application is submitted.
- 2 Flywire: Credit/Debit card payment services are provided. Cards that are ssued overseas are accepted only (Visa, Master and JCB)

*** Housing (Optional)**

Because on-campus housing is not guaranteed for all students due to the limited availability, housing is allotted on a first-come, first-served basis. Students are strongly recommended to apply for housing as soon as possible through the housing website dorm.yonsei.ac.kr/en after receiving your acceptance email.



Yonsei University is located in the center of the capital city of South Korea, Seoul, where you can witness a variety of traditional Korean culture. 2. Financial Report

Yonsei University received AEARU Funding Support (10,000 USD) for WAY program. The fund was used to distribute 3 types of scholarship to nominated students. Total of 33 students were nominated for AEARU-WAY scholarship:

- ❖ Scholarship type 1:
 - 5 nominated students received 100% tuition fee (1,440 USD) discount.
- Scholarship type 2:
 - 3 nominated students received 50% tutition fee + application fee (810 USD) discount.
- Scholarship type 3:

25 nominated students received partial discount for tuition fee (90 USD).

The excess amount (1,880 USD) was covered by Yonsei's own funding.
