Benefits (Fee-Paying Students Only)

- 1) Early Bird Promotion** All students who register by October 10, 2024 and pay tuition by October 17, 2024 will receive up to 15% discount.
- 2) Re-enrollment Benefit 100,000 KRW**
All students who have participated in the YISS or WAY program in the past are eligible to receive a fee benefit.

Scholarships

- 3) APRU & AEARU Associate University Scholarship 100,000 KRW**

All students enrolled at APRU and AEARU associate universities are eligible for the scholarship, which will be applied to their tuition fees.

- 4) Yonsei Alumni Scholarship 200,000 KRW**

All students whose parents are graduates of Yonsei University are eligible to the Yonsei Alumni Scholarship.

The Center of Traditional and Youth Culture

Founded in 1885, it is Korea's first modern Royal Hospital and the forerunner of today's Yonsei University Health System.



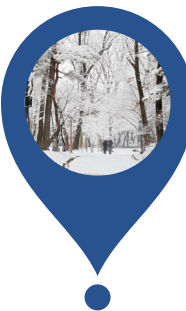
Underwood Memorial House
