# Application

## Application Period

**January 19 (Mon) - May 15 (Fri), 2026**

## Eligibility

- ◆ Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university
- ◆ Academically motivated high school students (age 18+ or in Year 12\*) or high school graduates (\*last year in high school)

## Required Documents

- ◆ Copy of academic transcript (or certified proof of enrollment for freshmen)
- ◆ Copy of passport
- ◆ Proof of health insurance (for students enrolled in in-person courses only)

## Application Procedures

**1.**

Complete the online application

**2.**

Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000 (non-refundable)

**3.**

Send the required documents to [isc@korea.ac.kr](mailto:isc@korea.ac.kr)

**4.**

Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance'

**5.**

Pay the tuition and all remaining fees

## Credit Transfer

Credits earned at KU ISC are widely transferable to most overseas institutions at the discretion of students' home institution. For credit transfer, students are advised to consult with the appropriate academic authorities at their home institution in advance by submitting the course syllabus available from the KU ISC website.

**\* One course is worth 3 credits, equivalent to the U.S. credit system.**
