## 1. Program Overview

Pusan National University (PNU) is pleased to host the 2026 Korea-Japan Joint Short-term Program, supported by the National Institute for International Education (NIIED) of Korea.

This program aims to promote academic exchange and mutual understanding between Korean and Japanese undergraduate students.

Participants will explore current economic and social issues in both countries and collaboratively develop practical solutions through lectures, field studies, and team-based projects.

## 2. Program Information

- ✓ Program Period: August 3 - August 21, 2026 (3 weeks)
- ✓ Location: Busan, Republic of Korea
- ✓ Field of Study: Business Administration / Economics
- ✓ Number of Participants: 20 undergraduate students
- ✓ Academic Credit: 3 credits awarded by PNU upon successful completion

## 3. Program Components

- ✓ Academic lectures in Business and Economics
- ✓ Project-based learning and team activities (Korea-Japan mixed teams)
- ✓ Field studies related to regional industries (e.g., tourism, finance)
- ✓ Korean language classes (beginner level)
- ✓ Korean culture lectures and cultural experiences

## 4. Financial Support (Fully Funded Program)

This program is fully funded by NIIED. The following expenses will be covered:

- Round-trip airfare
- Accommodation
- Program fees (lectures, field studies, cultural activities)

## 5. Eligibility

- 1 Undergraduate students majoring in Business Administration, Economics, or related fields
- 2 Have a minimum GPA of 3.5/4.5 or equivalent
- 3 Have sufficient English proficiency to participate in lectures conducted in English
- 4 Be in good physical and mental health

## 6. Selection Process

- ✓ All nominees will be comprehensively evaluated by PNU
- ✓ Selection will be based on academic performance and study plan
- ✓ The number of selected students may vary by institution
- ✓ Reserve candidates may be considered in case of withdrawals or vacancies

## 7. Timeline

- ✓ Nomination Deadline: April 20, 2026
- ✓ Application Deadline: April 30, 2026  
\*Only selected nominees will be invited to submit application documents.
- ✓ Final Result Announcement: Late May 2026
- ✓ Program Period: August 3 – August 21, 2026

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



### Q1. Is the program fully funded?

Yes. The program covers airfare, accommodation, and all program-related expenses.

### Q2. Who will arrange the airfare?

Pusan National University will provide guidance on airfare arrangements.

Detailed instructions will be given to selected participants.

### Q3. Is English proficiency required?

Yes. Participants must be able to understand and participate in lectures conducted in English.

### Q4. Can students from other majors apply?

Preference will be given to students majoring in Business Administration, Economics, or related fields.

### Q5. Will academic credit be awarded?

Yes. Participants will be awarded 3 academic credits by Pusan National University upon successful completion of the program.

Please note that credit transfer is subject to the regulations of each student's home university.

### Q6. Can reserve candidates be selected?

Yes. Reserve candidates may be selected if primary candidates withdraw or if additional places become available.

### Q7. Is accommodation provided?

Yes. Accommodation will be arranged and covered by PNU.

### Q8. What expenses are not covered?

Personal expenses such as meals outside the program, personal travel, and daily expenses are not included.
